To offer maximum support to pupils within their classes we aim to have a Teaching assistant in each classroom to enable focus work to be done with pupils.

To have a support teacher to work specifically with small groups to target the gaps in their learning at KS2

To support families by subsiding our enrichment activities eg residential visits, term time visits and other experiences which the children may miss out on due to financial constraints.
